- Course 1: Introduction to AI in Education
  - Objective: Familiarize faculty with foundational AI concepts and explore its potential in educational settings.
- Course 2: AI-Enhanced Instructional Practice
  - Objective: Equip faculty with skills to integrate AI into course design, delivery, and student engagement.
- Course 3: AI for Administrative Efficiency
  - Objective: Teach faculty to use AI tools to streamline grading, communication, and administrative tasks
